# May/August- Summary COVID-19 Report

Throughout out the period of the pandemic there has been several tasks we have completed. We will attach brief information to what we have been doing alongside attached photos.

## May.

Upon our return to work due to lockdown, we spent most of the month catching up on the cleansing of manor royal this included several fly tip removals, we believe the reason for this was the recycling centre being closed. Litter picking became a very noticeable issue this tasking us with a job of doing a complete blitz litter pick across the whole of manor royal. On the last week of this month (May) we then started our first grass cut.

## June/July

In these months our main aim was to completely dedicate the entire 8 weeks to grass cutting and litter/bins, as you can imagine this was an extremely slow process due to the height and thickness of the grass, we worked very hard to get it under our control and back to its best. Presentation is always a priority to us although this was a slow process and very time consuming it did pay off as within 6 weeks we had manor royal back to a well presented place of work.

## August

During the month of august now that we had the grass to a maintainable level we was able to step away from cutting for a week, Helped by the heat wave the grass was no longer growing at such an increased rate. This allowed us to follow up and complete several jobs that we had been needing to do. These tasks included...

- Weeding the terrace park.
- Remove bird's mouth fencing on Manor Royal Road.
- Weeded Gateway 1.
