

- Fly tipping increased in regards to small amounts. This takes up resource time as team have to clear. Area of concern zone 5
- Roadworks have impacted the standards of grass cutting this year. Due to ground conditions and continued roadworks and obstacles
- Homeless people have been occupying in Manor Royal (Tinsley lane North and Crompton Way) Ranger notified.
- Drug paraphernalia has been reported in Maxwell Way (Tinsley lane)
- Weed spraying has been completed on one occasion by maintenance team.
- Napier Way cleared path of detritus and leafs
- Weeded the Terrace and tightened seats due to lose fittings on seating.
- Crompton Way, cut and cleared hedge due to site line issues.
