Rutherford Way / Gatwick Road



Location:

The site is located on Gatwick Road Parade at the intersection of Gatwick Road and Rutherford Way.

The project area includes the area of grass with mature trees, the are of land in front of and to the side of 'Italian Pizza' and a section of shared footpath and cycle path.

Gatwick Road Parade is a prominent location for local businesses with high footfall and is opposite The Gatwick School.

The site falls within Zone 5 (Purple) and is an important location along the north/south link between Manor Royal and Gatwick.

Site features:

- A group of 9 mature trees:
- 300m from the beginning of bridleway 352Sy;
- Hexagonal covered seating area;
- Three paths cross the site, two are 1.7m wide footpaths and a 35m stretch of the National Cycle Route 21 which is a 2.5m shared path;
- The grass area is 465m in total and is adjoined by 41m² of paved area adjacent to 'Italian Pizza';
- A refuse storage area that holds 6 commercial bins adjacent to the building or on the roadside;
- There is evidence that the grass areas are frequently driven across;
- A variety of finger posts, free standing signs and signs fixed to trees add to the visual clutter; and
- The knee rail is in poor condition.


- Traffic movement and parking enhancements; • Proposals shown in the Project Pack;

Rutherford Way / Gatwick Road

Design Intent:

'Alfresco eating and meeting'.

The corner of Gatwick Road and Rutherford Way is at the northern end of the 'Parade'.

The current environment suffers from informal desire lines from people and vehicles, disorganised refused storage and inadequate and poorly located seating. The constraints include seven mature trees and a host of underground services, limiting the location for new infrastructure associated within the micro park.

The intent is to improve the current circulation routes by adding secondary routes across the site and improving the quality of the existing paths; to protect the existing trees by stopping vehicles and pedestrians compacting the ground around the roots of the trees; and to create new accessible 'meeting places' for people to use in groups or as individuals.

The concept design includes the idea of installing specific seating that encourages social interaction. Swivel chairs and diner style benches bring an element of fun and movement into the meeting spaces whilst providing essential seating for those visiting or passing Gatwick Parade. The micro park will be highly visible from busy Gatwick Road and will therefore help improve the identity. Fun elements, such as the swivel chairs and the potential public artwork will attract people to this micro park whilst helping tell part of the ongoing story of Manor Royal.
