Manor Royal West

Design Intent:

'A super hub bus stop and a key destination and arrival point within Gateway 2'

Manor Royal West - is a busy eastbound bus stop a highly visible site along Manor Royal and forms part of the sequence of arrival into Manor Royal from London Road (Gateway 2)

The intent is to create an attractive and highly visible micro park to help frame the potential new superhub bus shelter and provide additional space to sit, and socialise. The intent is to also improve the footpath alignments and connections to and from the bus stop from the shared cycle / walk way and the planned nearby toucan pedestrian crossing.

The proposed new bus stop shelter (outside of this this project scope) will be the dominant feature within the micro park. This will be complimented by a vegetated raingarden or area of planting, incidental seating walls and new paving.

The concept design includes many opportunities for public art such as wayfaring on the surfacing, seating and structures. Subject to further investigation there is also potential for the 7/8 substation kiosks to provide the canvas for the public artwork.
