Park Progress

One of our three capital projects in year one is the creation of the People's Park, which involves reclaiming the area known as Crawter's Brook and turning it into an attractive area for staff to use. Plans are being drawn up that include the potential to reinstate the path that linked Manor Royal (the road) with Fleming Way.



A planning application will be submitted by the end of the year and we will publish designs and plans as soon as they are available. Work is expected to start on-site in early 2014.

But that hasn't stopped staff from Tesco.com getting stuck in alongside young people from Sussex Central YMCA's "The Foyer" in West Green to start to clear Himalayan Balsam from the flood pond.

Procurement Hub providing savings



As well as looking at the potential for group buying, the BID has partnered with Auditel to provide a cost management facility to look at other ways businesses can save. Here are some examples of how that is working.

Since the last issue the MRBG has been looking at how to resolve problems associated with poor broadband. Our research looked at a range of technologies including WiFi, wireless and possible fibre solutions and involved a small task group of Manor Royal businesses.

As a group we have a much better understanding of what is out there and what the possibilities are. The project is at a critical phase and at the point of going to print a decision is about to be taken about which solution to commit to.

Roads resurfaced
