## Manor Royal Goes Wild

ave you noticed our new green space on Manor Royal? Last month, work on the People's Park was completed and we now all have a new outdoor area to enjoy. As well as providing a scenic spot for an outdoor lunch or quiet space to think, our People's Park provides a boardwalk, decking area, cycle paths, seating and picnic benches. It also opens up a wealth of volunteering opportunities thanks to a new partnership between the BID and Sussex Wildlife Trust.

Brought to you by the BID, the People's Park is open to all on Manor Royal and the general public. It also links Fleming Way with Manor Royal. The redevelopment was made possible by funding from the BID, along with a £350,000 grant from West Sussex County Council. Landscaping and the wildlife partnership means that the ecological value of the site will be enhanced on an ongoing basis.

The BID team welcomed the support of Coast to Capital Local Enterprise Partnership following a visit to the area by the LEP's former chairman John Peel OBE and its chief executive Ron Crank.

They were met by Trevor Williams and Steve Sawyer who both provided an update on the BID. The group then visited Elekta, which employs 900 people at Manor Royal and is a world leading company pioneering clinical solutions for treating cancer and brain disorders. They also toured the production line of Welland Medical, which specialises in the design, development and manufacture of stoma care pouches and accessories.

It was then a case of 'high tech' to 'handmade' when the LEP leaders visited Heyland &

Whittle, located in one of the original Manor Royal buildings. The familyrun business produces handmade quality soaps and fragrances using natural ingredients and traditional methods, and its many customers include John Lewis.

### Bola Lafe of Opus Innovations

Bola Lafe is, without doubt, a glass-half-full kind of man: when he gave up a career in investment banking in 2009 to start his own business, there simply was no option but to succeed...

#### Q: What does your company do?

BL: Opus Innovations was established to introduce innovative solutions to everyday problems, primarily in the healthcare and child care sectors. We were the proud winners of the Gatwick Diamond New Business Award 2014. The company moved to Manor Royal in 2011 to set up a manufacturing plant for our flagship product Aquaint - the UK's safest multipurpose natural sanitiser.

#### Q: Why Manor Royal?

BL: It is very central from a logistics and transport perspective, which is very important for us. Being connected via MRBD is also a big advantage and the BID is a great initiative. Being based on Manor Royal is a bit different from the early days of operating from a home office in Orpington!

#### Q: What activities would you like BID to do?

BL: In my opinion, a priority is to connect companies on Manor Royal and generate as much cross-selling opportunities as possible. This initiative has already been kicked off by MRBD with the 'Buy Manor Royal' project, and I am very pleased to be on the working group that is driving this forward.

BL: To make Aquaint a household name in as many countries as possible. It is a revolutionary sanitiser as it is like water - it kills 99.9% of bacteria, but it is completely safe to swallow or to even use on the skin of a new born baby and on surfaces too, even food!
