




Survival of the Fittest; Beetles have Survived Centuries by Adapting

Source: HM Treasury; LGA: 2010-11 baseline as estimated in SR2010 and compares it to estimated spending in 2015/16 as per SR2013




A recent survey of local authority chief executives asked the question: "What will your organisation look like in 5 years' time?". The most common answer was:

"I haven't a clue".







Chart: Forecast Demographic Changes









