



RUN GATWICK 2026 – SUNDAY 10th MAY 2026 SPECIAL NOTICE - RUN GATWICK ROAD CLOSURES

The Run Gatwick Half Marathon and 5k is returning to central Crawley on Sunday 10th May 2026.

This re-launched Run Gatwick Half Marathon and 5k Road Race will start and finish from Southgate Park where participants will be set off at 09:00. Participants will have the option to either run a half marathon or 5k distance. Road closures are required and will be in place between 08:00 and 14:00, with roads reopened behind the last runner.

The event route consists of a looped half marathon route starting and finishing at Southgate Park. The event route goes clockwise from central Crawley up to Charlwood along Ifield Avenue, underneath Gatwick Airport before returning to central Crawley via Manor Royal, Northgate Avenue, The Boulevard and Crawley High Street. The 5km loop sits within the half marathon route and splits off at the Ifield Avenue / London Road roundabout and returns back to Southgate Park via The Boulevard and Crawley High Street.

Safety is our number one priority, and to ensure our runners and spectators are safe en-route, we will be closing some local roads for a short time on race day. This may affect you in some way.

We work closely with Crawley Borough Council, Surrey County Council, Sussex and Gatwick Police to minimise inconvenience for local business and residents. Some local roads will be closed for a period of time between 08:00 and 14:00 with all road closures managed by approved Road Traffic Controllers and supported by our experienced and friendly Race Marshals.

How this will affect Manor Royal

The following roads will be closed between 08:30-12:15 in Manor Royal:

- London Road Northbound between County Oak Retail Park to Lowfield Heath Roundabout
- London Road Southbound between Fleming Way Roundabout to Manor Royal Road
- Manor Royal Road between London Road and Faraday Road

Access into and out of Manor Royal

- Access will remain open from the north via London Road southbound providing access into and out of Maple Parking, Premier Inn London Gatwick, Hydehurst Lane and into Fleming Way.
- Fleming Way remains open providing access into and out of all joining roads including Faraday Road, Newton Road and Gatwick Road. There will be no access onto London Road from Fleming Way.
- Manor Royal Road will remain open from Faraday Road to Gatwick Road providing access into and out of all joining roads including Faraday Road, Newton Road and Gatwick Road.
- Acorn Retail Park will be closed however there will be pedestrian access from County Oak Retail Park.
- All of County Oak will remain open, including the Retail Park, County Oak Way and Metcalf Way. Access in will be from the south on the Northbound London Road from Crawley Avenue. Access out will be directed south to Crawley Avenue.

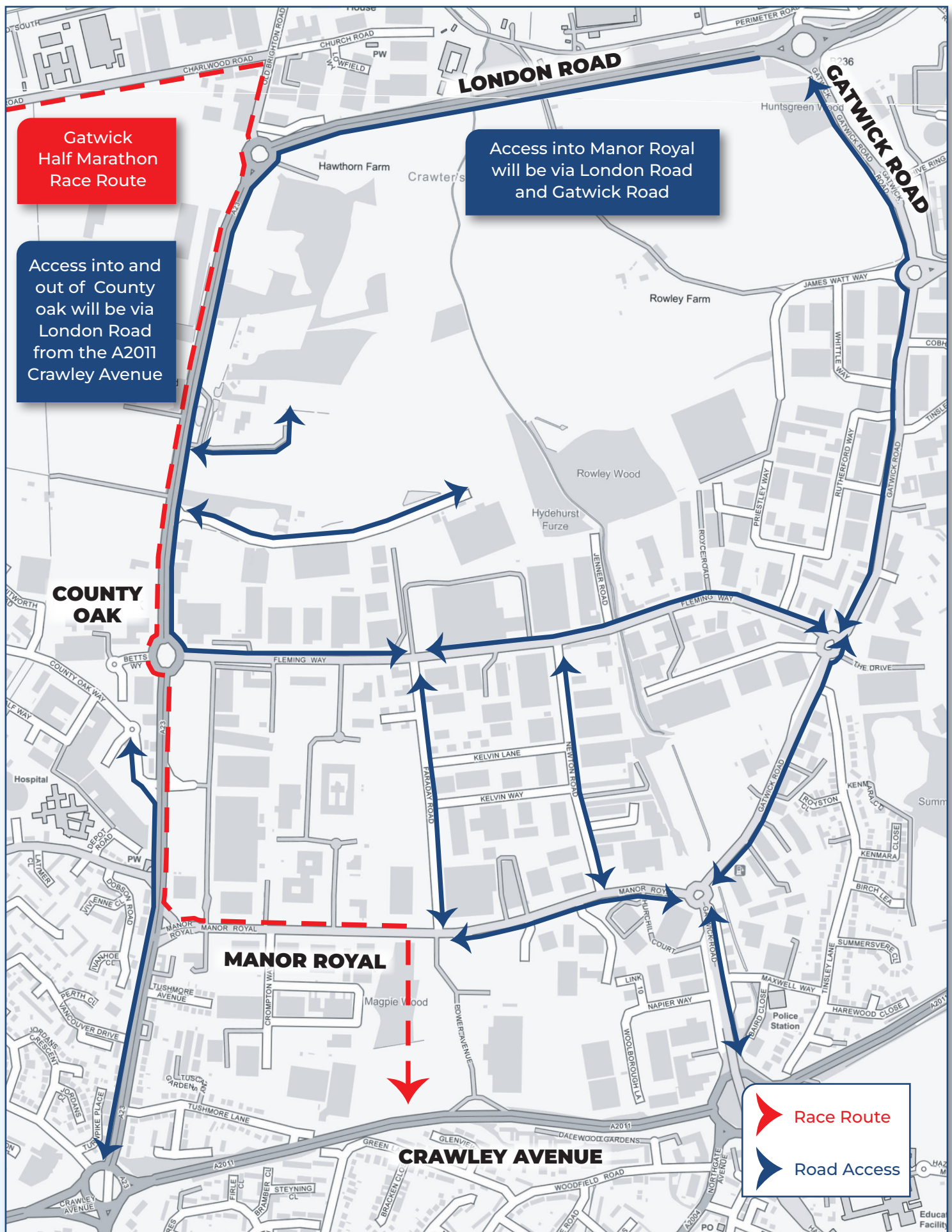
