Manor Royal Bus Lane

The Manor Royal Highways Improvement project is an integral part of the Crawley Growth Programme which is being delivered by West Sussex County Council (WSCC), Crawley Borough Council and Manor Royal BID. Partners have invested over £3 million into improving the infrastructure, look and traffic flow in the area by Autumn 2023.

What we're doing

The next phase involves widening the carriageway along Manor Royal between Crawley Business Quarter and Gatwick Road Roundabout to enable the introduction of an eastbound bus lane.

When this will take place

The work will start on 6th February and is expected to take 7 months to complete. Our hours of work will generally be between 7:30am and 5:00pm.

Road Restrictions during the work

The work will be carried out in such a way to limit disruption. However, there will inevitably be a need for some traffic management. The existing westbound bus lane restriction will be suspended to allow for all traffic. Access will be maintained at all times.
