

Manor Royal Highways Improvements Scheme, Crawley Growth Programme

Details of associated roadworks (Date: 05 August 2022)



Background

The Crawley Growth Programme is a £60m investment package of improvements across the town to support business investment and employment growth involving Coast to Capital Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP), West Sussex CC, Crawley BC and Manor Royal BID and others. Over £3.5m will be directly invested in Manor Royal to improve key junctions, cycling and walking facilities, traffic signals, a new eastbound bus lane on Manor Royal, improve bus waiting areas and explore options for improving parking.

Associated roadworks

The work in Manor Royal will be delivered in a series of phases. The first phase of work to improve the operation of the junction and signals at County Oak Way, Martyrs Avenue, new Toucan crossings on London Road, Crompton Way and Manor Royal and associated public realm and walking and cycling upgrades have already been completed.

The next phase of work, detailed below, will be carried out in such a way to limit disruption. However, there will inevitably be a need for some traffic management.

The following table provides the dates for planned work associated with the next phase of the Crawley Growth Programme in Manor Royal.
